Clinical Research Awards

The Global Health Institute Clinical Research Award program supports UW-Madison and UW Health clinicians, graduate medical trainees, and students in relevant programs who are exploring potential research topics that will enhance global health clinical activities on the UW-Madison campus and beyond. GHI will award several grants in amounts of up to \$5,000 for a duration of one year.

Proposal Requirements

The proposals should clearly address:

- How the project will advance the [vision and mission](http://ghi.wisc.edu/about/mission-and-vision) of GHI (ghi.wisc.edu/about/mission-and-vision) and your clinical research
 - Why GHI funding is essential for the research
 - Other sources of funding the applicant is pursuing
 - Budgets must be reviewed for compliance with UW and divisional travel and financial policies by the appropriate grants administrator and/or financial supervisor in the applicant's department or division prior to submitting the final application. It is the responsibility of the PI to know and comply with UW and their own divisional policies and procedures.
 - Previous Clinical Research Award recipients within the past three years are not eligible.
 - The application deadline for all proposals is 11:59 p.m. Monday, **January 24, 2022**.
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To Apply

Individuals who plan to apply for a Clinical Research Award must:

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Application

The following application components must be on single-spaced, numbered pages (11-point font or larger, 1-inch margins) assembled into a **single PDF file**:

- GHI Title Page, including abstract:** Use GHI template found online at <https://ghi.wisc.edu/wp-content/uploads/sites/168/2021/11/GHI-Application-Title-Page-2022.pdf>



Project description (up to 4 pages), including the following sections:

1. Introduction, including how your project fits the vision and mission of GHI
2. Aims/Hypotheses
3. Methods
4. Relevance to global health
5. Explain how project will overcome potential/perceived operational limitations due to COVID-19 restrictions that could hinder completion.

Detailed budget for amount requested. (including justification). Detailed budget with break downs of expenditures, as appropriate. Include item-by-item justification of the budget, why GHI funding is essential for this project, and why alternative sources of funding are not appropriate or available. Salaries, tuition and stipends cannot be supported with these funds. The award is in the form of 150 funds. Budget must be reviewed for compliance with UW System and divisional travel and financial policies by the appropriate grants administrator and/or financial supervisor in the applicant's department or division prior to submitting the final application. The name of the person reviewing the budget must be listed on the GHI Application Title Page in Box 10.

Bio-sketch. A copy of the applicant's bio-sketch completed using the NIH Biographical Sketch Format Page: <https://grants.nih.gov/grants/forms/biosketch.htm>

References. Must include a letter of support from the applicant's supervisor/department chair.

The following considerations apply to GHI Awards:

Awards will be announced in late February 2022 and funds will be transferred to the recipients department/unit soon after awardees are notified. The award is in the form of 150 funds, which will carry over between fiscal years.

As a condition of receiving GHI funding, you must agree to:

- Follow all UW travel and financial policies, as well as the applicant's divisional policies, which are sometimes more restrictive;
- Participate in the community of global health scholars on campus by presenting research results at appropriate GHI-sponsored events;
- Acknowledge GHI funding in all resulting publications and presentations. (Sample text: "This project was funded/partially funded through a Clinical Research Award from the University of Wisconsin-Madison Global Health Institute."); and
- Provide annual and final accountability reports to GHI regarding the use of funds.
